## Education order fulfillment process

The following information describes how to receive your serial number and complete the installation of your Adobe Student Edition software. You must have a serial number to use this product beyond the 30-day trial period.

You must have the following information to complete the registration process:

- An e-mail address
- Product code printed above

## Use restrictions

You may purchase only one license of any Adobe Student Edition product. You can use this license only on your privately owned computer. Student Edition products may not be resold by the end user.

## Eligible individuals

Only full- or part-time students enrolled at a higher education institution qualify. A higher education institution is defined as an accredited public or private university or college (including community, junior, or vocational colleges) that grants degrees requiring not less than the equivalent of two (2) years of full-time study.

## Proof of eligibility

You must provide a copy of a valid, current student ID that includes your name and photo and a date. If you do not have an ID with this information, you must provide a photocopy of a valid photo ID and one of the following items:

- Official, current, photo student ID with name and date
- Official, current school transcript with your name and the name of the school
- Official, current school tuition bill with your name and the name of the school
- Official, current report card with your name and the name of the school
- Other official, dated proof of enrollment

Students who are under 18 and do not have a valid photo ID may provide an official letter from their eligible educational institution stating their name and current enrollment status.

You may use a digital camera or scanner to create a copy of your proof of eligibility. Make sure that all documents are clear, legible, and true to size. Acceptable formats include JPEG, GIF, BMP, TIF, and PDF. The file must be no larger than 3MB.
