



How Lumion Licensing works

Named-user license

A named-user license is assigned to one specific person, giving them access to the software on any machine.

- The software can be installed on multiple computers.
- Each user can only be logged in on one device at a time.
- Admins can add or remove users from the license at any time.
- The number of assigned users must match the number of seats on the license.

Benefits

- Easy user management – add or remove users anytime, with full visibility into who's using the software.
- Simple and secure access – each user has their own login.
- Use on any device – install Lumion on multiple machines and log in wherever you work.
- Ideal for solo professionals or small teams.

Software access

Simply log in to use the software using your Lumion Account credentials.

Availability

Lumion View and Lumion Pro are available as named-user licenses.

Floating license

A floating license allows multiple people to use Lumion without needing to log in. The license “floats” between users—whoever needs it can run the software, as long as a seat is available.

- The software can be installed on multiple computers.
- The number of concurrent users needs to match the number of seats on the license.

Benefits

- Cost-efficient for teams – great for firms where team members use Lumion at different times.
- Flexible use – anyone can access the software from any machine, as long as a seat is free.

Software access

When installing the software, you'll be prompted to enter a unique activation key for your floating license.

Availability

Lumion Studio includes Lumion Pro as a floating license.
